

Eat. LEED. Ski. A Mid-winter Sampler.

Join the Nature Inn at Bald Eagle for a sampling of what the Park, Inn and region have to offer during the winter months. This all inclusive, two night stay is designed to introduce you to our sustainability efforts and recreational opportunities.

Activities begins with Park led programming as you explore the snowscape during *Nature on Snowshoes*. Explore the winter woods on snowshoes and discover what animals are out and about during this blustery season.

Friday's reception and dinner highlight locally sourced, sustainably raised meat, cheeses and vegetables and will be followed by a fireside screening of *The Greening of Southie*. This film tells the story of the first LEED certified green building in South Boston, the pride and confusion it generates, and the people who made it possible.

Saturday's *Cross Country Ski Adventure* provides an opportunity to learn the basics of this popular wintertime activity and then take in some beautiful scenery during a three mile excursion. Park Naturalist, Nick Thomas, will point out bird species sighted along the way and provide you with natural history tidbits ranging from winter wildflowers to eagle ecology. Ski Adventure will begin at 9:00 AM, with an hour-long introduction and orientation followed by two full hours on the park's trails.

A light, locally sourced luncheon will be followed by the chance to get out on F.J. Sayers Reservoir for an *Ice Fishing Demonstration* with an opportunity for participants to try their hand at this favorite of winter pastimes.

Dinner Saturday will be followed by a presentation on the adventure of a lifetime, a ten-month, 6,500 mile journey on a 19th century styled, solar powered canal boat. Cynthia Berger and Bill Carlsen will speak about their rewarding voyage as they take you along on this virtual tour.

The weekend will be capped off with an Innkeeper led *Green Building Tour* on Sunday morning immediately following breakfast.
