Has winter got you down? Is cabin fever beginning to set in?

Then join the staff of the Nature Inn at Bald Eagle State Park for an exciting winter package full of birds, brew, and everything local!

On Friday evening kick off your stay with a welcome dinner in the Great Room. After dinner there will be a wine tasting from one of central Pennsylvania's local premiere wineries. After trying a few samples and picking out a favorite, guests will learn the art of wildlife painting during an instructed Paint & Sip to round out the evening.

After a hearty breakfast Saturday morning, a Winter Bird Walk will take you along the trails of Bald Eagle State Park and introduce you to common winter bird species and the tools birders use to identify them. To warm up, lunch will feature another tasting event from a local brewery. The afternoon will be a treat as we receive a private tour of the nation's first "green" distillery at Big Spring Spirits, located a short drive away in historic Bellefonte. Following the tour, dinner will await us within the comfort of the Nature Inn. After dinner, participants will be treated to an evening of nocturnal nature and may even have the chance to hear the hooting calls of the "ghost of the night."

To round out your stay, wake up early and join the park naturalist for a Sunday Morning Birding Tour and explore the park one last time before checking out and concluding the weekend.
