You will also receive tickets to the center's immersive 4-D theatre. This will be followed by a horse-drawn wagon ride around the grounds which will provide another chance for viewing elk against the colorful early Autumn backdrop. Be sure to bring your cameras and to dress for the weather!

Pricing includes all items detailed to the right. Guests must provide their own transportation for the auto tour or carpool with others. Total mileage of the auto tour from Bald Eagle State Park to the Elk Country Visitor Center is about 160 miles round trip.
